The Chairman said the meeting had been called to discuss a letter which the Community Council had drafted to submit to the Regional Planning Department regarding the latest application for commercial use of Middlefield as a long term grain store. He said he had discussed the situation with the Chairman of the Planning Committee who thought that the Committee would probably approve the application but that safeguards would be incorporated prohibiting increase in size and that it would be as stated - without dryer.

The letter was studied page by page and it was said to be very reasonable in relation to the results gathered from the survey of the village.

Mr Baillie moved that it be adopted and sent to the applicant as well as the Director of Planning; seconded by Mr Markby; carried.

It was stated that our Planning Consultant would also be making a submission.

It was decided to send a copy of the letter to the Berwickshire News for printing in that week's paper. Mr Markby proposed that if it were to be edited in any way then the Community Council would have to approve before publication; seconded by Mr Baillie; carried.

The meeting was then thrown open to the public, and more discussion took place.
