The Chairman welcomed Mr Lorimer who had been asked to attend by Maj Askew.

2 Planning Application for Middlefield Granary

The Planning Application for a long term grain store at Middlefield was fully discussed by the Community Council. Mr Lorimer said the Planning Committee would take into account the fact that during the previous year there had been no complaints received with regard to noise or dust caused by the lorries transporting grain. He promised to let the Community Council have a copy of Philip Wilson's letter detailing their intentions for the site which stated the lorries would not be expected to go through Gavinton. Miss Burns-Greig was asked if she would care to make any comments but declined to do so.

It was accepted unanimously by the Community Council that the following 3 conditions should be recommended to be included in the Planning permission:-

- 1 permission should be granted for not more than 5 years.
- 2 use of site and building only between 8 am and 6 pm, Monday to Saturday, no use of site on Sunday.
- 3 surrounding woodland to be retained and managed.
