- 1 Mrs Darling welcomed Mr Pagan to talk about the Jim Clark Rally, as he could not come to the ordinary meeting on 25 September.

The concerns of the village especially with regard to parking during the Rally were put to him. He recognised these and said the Rally organisers would be looking at the situation in the next few weeks and he agreed to come to the Community Council meeting on 6 November to report their decisions.

He was also informed of the proposed Waste Transfer Station.

- 2 Mrs Darling said she had received a letter from Mr Robinson, Robinson Associates, quoting a fee of £1,700 + VAT and expenses to be our Consultant. It was agreed to retain him but Mrs Darling was to ensure that he would produce a report of his work. She would also ask him how good a case he thought we had.
- 3 Mrs Darling and Mr Marjoribanks to go to SBC Policy and Resources Committee meeting on 19 September as Item 11 was relevant.
- 4 Mr Marjoribanks had made an analysis of the case which showed that the Waste Transfer Station would be better sited to the east of Berwickshire at somewhere like Craigswalls or Chirnside.
- 5 Euan Robson, MSP, had been in touch and supports our case. Mr Seed gave the Chairman a letter of support from Archie Kirkwood MP, for the file.
- 6 The fund-raising Quiz evening on Saturday, 16 September, had been very successful and raised £400. Another was planned for about 3 weeks time. Grateful thanks expressed to the small group who do the organising and provide refreshments. Donations of £300 have also been received by Mr Marjoribanks, Fighting Fund Hon Treasurer.
