

## GAVINTON, FOGO & POLWARTH COMMUNITY COUNCIL

### Minutes of a Meeting held at Gavinton Church Hall on Monday 24 April 2006 at 7pm

1. Apologies for absence were received from Mr N Humphrey, Mrs J Seed, Mrs C Taylor, Cllr. M McCrave
2. Police input: there was nothing to report
3. Minutes of meeting held on Monday 13 March 2006 were approved with two minor amendments to Matters Arising:
4. Matters arising:
  - Carriageway repairs in Gavinton are still not completed, as there are potholes to be filled. CC members expressed their disappointment at this.
  - State of roads and verges in Fogo was discussed. Some problems are being caused by very wide farm vehicles. It was agreed that SB Local could be asked to make repairs, but not if it was going to occur again; the cause has to be solved first.
  - Dog fouling in Gavinton: there have been three further complaints. Mrs Darling reported that there are 27 dogs in the village, with 19 owners. It was agreed to put up posters to remind owners that not clearing up after their dogs is an offence.
  - Household waste arrangements: Mrs Darling is to raise the questions of why so little plastic qualifies for uplifting, and if there is a weight limit for paper collections at the next Berwickshire Area Committee meeting.
5. Planning applications:
  - Polwarth: 10 houses refused 10 April for a variety of reasons. SBC has been notified that their most recent letter still refers to '30' houses.
  - Land NE of Langton Edge: erection of dwellinghouse: there is a potential problem with water supply.
  - Polwarth Bank: erection of conservatory (notification only)
  - Woodlea, Caldra: erection of conservatory (notification only)
  - Whinkerstone Farmhouse: extensions to dwellinghouse (notification only)
6. Treasurer's report: now that various payments agreed have been made, the accounts stand at £385 in the ordinary account, and £414 in the other account (for computer).
